

WI FFA Alumni State Council Goals

1. Increase State Membership by 200 members per year
(5 year goal to increase by 1000 new members)
2. All sections represented by 2 people on the council
3. Provide leadership training to council members each year
(i.e. Provide leadership training to new council members.)
4. Provide leadership training opportunities to affiliate leaders around the state.
5. Encourage all council members attend State FFA Convention in June. Offer services as judge, etc.
6. Sectional meetings (fall and spring) to be attended by 50% of the affiliates in that section
7. State FFA Alumni convention in February attended by 50% of all affiliates with an increase of 1 each year from each section.
8. Develop and maintain an affiliate manual for all affiliates as a resource from the WI FFA Alumni Assn.
9. Maintain a recreational or fun activity each year for the affiliates in Wisconsin, other than the State Alumni Convention. (i.e. Brewers Outing)
10. Chapter Grants – All sections having at least 2 FFA Chapters apply annually.
11. WLC Scholarships – 5 chapters from each section fill out applications
12. Council Meeting Schedule – February*, March+, June*, September+ and November*.
+ Friday evening leadership sessions
* State committee meeting sessions – time to be determined.

Alumni Awards:

- Outstanding Affiliate Award – 2 applications from each section.
- Scrapbook Award – 1 entry from each section.
- Outstanding Achievement Award – 1 entry from each section.
- Newsletter Award – 1 entry from each section.
- Outstanding Ag Instructor – 1 entry from each section.
- Legion of Merit Awards – have applicants from 5 affiliates from each section
